## **Association Committees**

The River North Residents Association is a volunteer-led non-profit community organization, working to protect and enhance the quality of life in River North. Our committees are comprised of civic-minded residents working together on a wide range of issues affecting our neighborhood. ### **Commerce Committee**

The Commerce Committee exists to manage, enhance and expand RNRA's relationship with the local business community and to promote responsible commerce in River North.

### **Development and Land Use Committee**

The Development and Land Use Committee exists to ensure that real estate development is planned and executed in a thoughtful manner that enhances the community and considers the interests of all stakeholders.

### **Family Committee**

The Family Committee exists to support and engage families with young children and to expand RNRA's relationship with this segment of the River North community.

### **Marketing Committee**

The Marketing Committee exists to oversee the organization's public relations initiatives, promote its programs and activities and manage external communication through all channels.

### **Membership Committee**

The Membership Committee exists to promote RNRA as an essential resource in River North and to enhance and expand the organization's relationship with the local residential community.

### **Parks Committee**

The Parks Committee exists to enhance and promote A. Montgomery Ward Park and to advocate for the creation and improvement of public green spaces throughout River North.

### **Pet Owners Committee**

The Pet Owners Committee exists to promote responsible pet ownership in River North and to support, engage and expand RNRA's relationship with the local pet owning community.

### **Public Safety Committee**

The Public Safety Committee exists to improve public safety in River North by encouraging and facilitating constructive engagement between local residents, businesses, public safety officials and other stakeholders.

### **RNCS Committee**

The RNCS Committee exists to administer and promote River North Clean Streets, a 501(c)(3) creating opportunities for disadvantaged Chicagoans to achieve independence through neighborhood beautification.

### **Executive Committee**

The Executive Committee is comprised of the association's officers and selected Board members. The committee exercises the power of the Board of Directors between regular meetings of the Board and when timing is critical. It also assists the Board with development, special projects and strategic planning.
